## Domaine La Colombette Rosé, 2018, Languedoc, France

Get your nose into this & it smells so good, it's hard to put it back out again. It positively oozes summer, whatever season you open it. This winery started in 1890 but it was Francois Pugibet who modernised the winery in 1966, doing away with herbicides & insecticides, & planting more unusual grape varieties.

### What We Taste:

Strawberry, raspberry, mint, peach and white flowers.

## Domaine des Aspras Les Trois Freres, 2018, Provence, France

The work on their land & in the cellar is guided by the determination to make an organic wine, which is a truly a reflection of the exceptional land from which it grows. The winery is located in the village of Correns, Provence, the first totally organic village in France. In the XIII century the Benedictine monks knew already the potential of wine-making of this region.

### What We Taste:

Strawberry, raspberry, mint, peach and white flowers.

## Les Frères Laffitte Rosé, 2017, Cotes de Gascogne, France

Red summer fruits, first a bouquet, then a basquet, are countered by juuuuust enough citrus refreshment. Drink after an hour in the warm sun, tilt your head back and tilt. Bas-Armagnac is known as the home of the swashbuckling D'Artagnan, & the brothers Laffitte have an "all for one & one for all" vibe to them. The vines are planted on the highest hills on the borders of Gascony.

### What We Taste:

Red fruits and berries with a hint of citrus.

## Girolamo Russo Rosato, 2018, Sicily, Italy

At 32, Giuseppe Russo was a classical pianist & doctor of letters who knew nothing about making wine. Then his father, Girolamo, died of a sudden heart attack while working in the family vineyards. Made from the oldest part of the Giuseppe Russo's single-vineyard San Lorenzo, this rosato is juicy and refreshing thanks to the clean cut of minerality that runs through it.

### What We Taste:

Pomegranates, wild strawberries.
