Bas-Armagnac is known as the home of the swashbuckling D'Artagnan, and the brothers Laffitte have an "all for one and one for all" vibe to them. Come here, you ray of sunshine. Red summer fruits, first a bouquet, then a basket, are countered by juuuuust enough citrus refreshment. Drink after an hour in the warm sun, tilt your head back and drift.

"Licorne" means "unicorn" in French; the symbol has been representing the Latz family since the 18th century. Wines produced under the Cuvée Licorne are highly sought-after and aged in wooden oak barrels. The mysterious alchemy between wine and wood gives its fame. The maker's motto: *Know thyself*. Looking for enlightenment (and a flippin' tasty rosé)? Follow the unicorn.

What We Taste:

Intense and complex nose marked by aromas of vanilla

Russo Rosato,
Etna DOC,

From the oldest part of Giuseppe Russo's single-vineyard San Lorenzo plot, this rosato is juicy and refreshing thanks to the clean cut of minerality that runs through it. As with many of his wines, you get the distinct impression that the ever-thoughtful Giuseppe learned all there is to know about Sicilian rosato before he began.

What We Taste:

Red fruits and berries with a hint of citrus.
